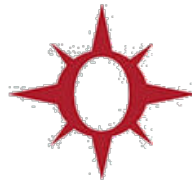

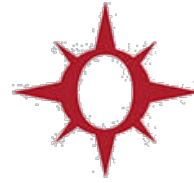

It is intended to synthesize your leadership experience on campus and your plan for continuous learning. Draws upon your leadership learning for the purpose of engaging in intentional change.</p>
